
















User Manual



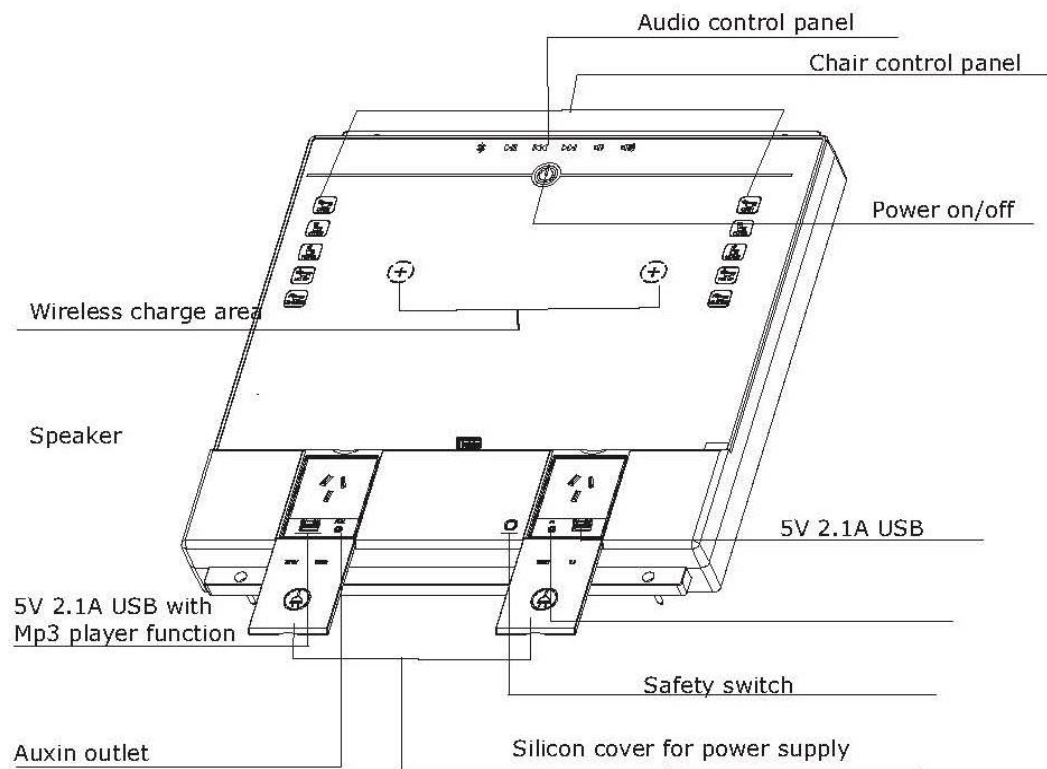
Operation

- » Plug the unit into a household power supply. (AC 100~240V)
- » Touch  for a while to turn on the device. All buttons light on and the BT begins to search signal.
- » Turn on the BT function of your device, search BT the signal "eMoMo iTable406". Pair your BT device with the "eMoMo iTable406". If it is paired successfully, a "Du" sound will be made and you can Play music with your BT device. If you want to disconnect the BT, touch  for 3s to disconnect it.
- » Touch  to play or pause the music file.
- » Touch  time after time to decrease volume gradually. Touch and hold it to decrease volume rapidly.
- » Touch  time after time to increase volume gradually. Touch and hold it to increase volume rapidly.
- » Touch  to back to the last track.
- » Touch  to switch into the next track.
- » Connect your AUX device to the product via  outlet by an AUX cable, the audio will switch into AUX audio mode automatically and you can play music via your AUX device.
- » Insert a USB has MP3 audio file in into the USB outlet next to AUX-IN outlet, the audio will switch into USB MP3 player and automatically. Available for mp3/.mp2/.wma/.asf/.wmv/.wav/.aif/.aiff/.aifc/.m4a/.aac/.mp4/.mov/.flac.
- » Touch  shortly could cut off the AUX and USB connection. Then you can pair the BT and play music via BT device.
- » Connect your earphones with  outlet to listen music via earphones.
- » Touch  to recline the chair.
- » Touch  to close the chair.
- » Touch  to return the chair to Upright Position.
- » Touch  to lift the headrest.
- » Touch  to retract the headrest.
- » Put your device on the wireless charging area to charge for it. Ensure that the receiver of your device is aligned with  logo.
- » If unexpected problem is took place on the product, like water flow in, the safety switch will cut off the power then pop up. Press it down after troubleshooting, then it could work normally. But if it remains in trouble, the safety switch cannot be press down.
- » Swivel clockwise to open the silicon cover of the sockets.

Frequently Asked Questions

Problem	Possible cause and correction
No power	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The plug is plugged into a useless socket. Change a useful socket. 2. The plug isn't plugged properly. Re-plug it. 3. The safety switch has pop up. Press it down, then try to turn it on again.
No sound at all	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The volume switch is on minimum. Increase the volume. 2. The music is paused. Re-play it. 3. It isn't in the corresponding play mode. Touch  to switch into the right mode.
The unit doesn't response	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The unit is in poor connected. Check all connectors and reconnect them if it's necessary. 2. There is interference source around. Remove it and try to turn it on 15 seconds later. 3. It is crashed because of improper operation. Reconnect the power supply, then try to turn it on 15 seconds later.
The Bluetooth can't be paired	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It has been connected to the other device. Press  for a while to disconnect the previous BT connection and try it again. 2. Do not pair the Bluetooth behind a wall or in a corner. Keep the working space in 8M. 3. It is not in the Bluetooth mode. Touch  to switch into the Bluetooth mode.
USB mode can't work	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Available for mp3/.mp2/.wma/.asf/.wmv / .wav/.aif/.aiff/.aifc/.m4a/.aac/.mp4/.mov / .flac format. Others can't be played. 2. The USB is broken. Try to change a useful one. 3. It is not in the USB player mode. Touch  to switch into the USB player mode. 4. Ensure is is inserted in the USB outlet with the USB player function.
AUX mode can't work	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The music source is useless. Try another one. 2. The auxin cable is useless. Change a useful one. 3. It is not in the AUXIN player mode. Touch  to switch into the AUXIN player mode. 4. Ensure your device has the auxin function.
